- 512 MB RAM or higher
- Windows® XP SP2, Windows Vista®, or Windows® 7
- 16-bit color or higher
- 1024 x 768 screen resolution recommended
- Adobe® Reader® 7.0, 8.0, or 9.0
- Microsoft® Word 2003, 2007, or 2010
- Microsoft® Excel 2003 or 2007 (required by Learning Portal Managers who generate reports)
- Adobe® Flash® Player 9 or 10
- Windows Media® Player 9, 10, or 11 (required for the Techniques for a High-Performance Workforce V. 2.29 courses)
- Speakers or headphones for multimedia
- Internet connection speed to view videos: 56 Kbps or higher
